This simple checklist can assist you with identifying potentially non-compliant Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) in the Australia marketplace. These are just a few of the simpler checks that our scientists do when reviewing every SDS added or updated on ChemAlert.

Note: The following applies to Hazardous Chemicals only and does not relate to goods exempted from requiring a GHS-compliant Safety Data Sheet.
